- ✓ Final project file(s) and AI tools used
- ✓ Project title and short description
- ✓ Clear Student photograph
- ✓ “Meet the Creator” selfie video (if ready)
- ✓ Google Drive links (if your files are larger than 10 MB)

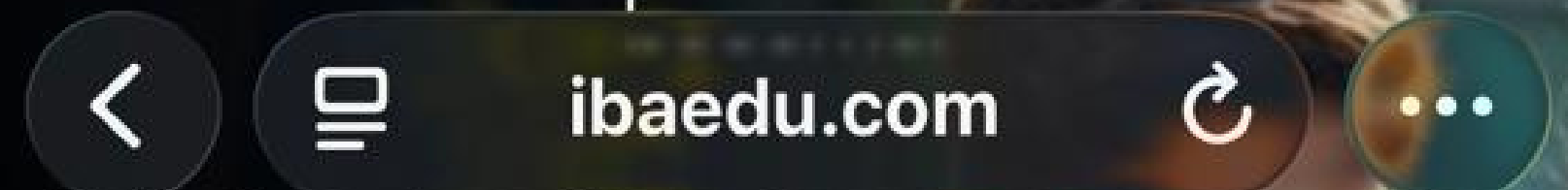

FILE IS 10 MB OR SMALLER?

DIRECT UPLOAD

Upload it directly through the form where the upload field is provided.

FILE IS LARGER THAN 10 MB?

GOOGLE DRIVE LINK

Upload to Google Drive and share the link in the designated field.

YOUR VIDEO IS LARGER THAN 10 MB?

DON'T WORRY. USE GOOGLE DRIVE.

For the video-based categories from Section 4 to Section 7, you can either:



OPTION 1: Upload the video directly to the Google Form if it is within the permitted 10 MB upload limit.



OPTION 2: Upload the video to Google Drive and paste the shareable link into the Google Drive Video Link field.

HOW TO UPLOAD YOUR VIDEO TO GOOGLE DRIVE



Open Google Drive and Sign in with your Google account.

Choose your final video file and wait until the upload is finished.

IMPORTANT: Do not copy the link before the upload is completely finished.

MAKE SURE OUR JUDGING TEAM CAN VIEW IT

After uploading your video to Google Drive, follow these exact steps:

- Right-click the file and click **“Share”**.
- Find “General access” and change to:
ANYONE WITH THE LINK
- Make sure the permission is set to:
VIEWER
- Click “Copy link” and paste it into the Google Form.

STOP! TEST YOUR LINK BEFORE YOU SUBMIT

This is an important quality-control step. **A LINK THAT ONLY YOU CAN OPEN CANNOT BE EVALUATED.**

How to Test

- 1 Open a private/incognito browser window OR use
 - another Google account/device where practical.
- 2 Paste the copied Google Drive link.
-
- 3 Check whether the video can be viewed.
-
- 4 Make sure the judging team does not need to request
 - access.
- 5 If access is restricted, return to Google Drive and
 - change the setting to: Anyone with the link → Viewer

Test Checklist

- ☐ Video opens
- ☐ Video plays
- ☐ No access request appears
- ☐ Sharing is “Anyone with the link”
- ☐ Permission is “Viewer”
- ☐ Correct video has been linked

SECTION 8: MEET THE CREATOR

This section gives the judging and championship team an opportunity to see the young creator behind the project. You may be asked to provide a short selfie video introducing yourself.



Record a short selfie video.



Introduce your name, age, and school.



Briefly tell us what you created.



Share what your teacher means to you.

DON'T WORRY ABOUT BEING PERFECT. We want to see YOU.
Keep it natural and authentic.

YOUR PHOTOGRAPH (MANDATORY)

Upload a clear, recent photograph

This photograph may be used for winner announcements, the online felicitation ceremony, certification, the Wall of Fame, and social media recognition.

Avoid:

- Blurry or very dark photographs
- Group photographs
- Images where the student is difficult to identify

By submitting the photograph, parents/guardians understand it may be used for official championship recognition purposes.
